2019 Outreach and Mission

Christ and The Epiphany is committed to both local outreach and global mission.

Loose plate money given on the first Sunday of each month goes into the priest's discretionary fund and can be used for any charitable cause. Local outreach is done with the money collected in the change jars located in the church and chapel. For 2019 a donation of \$100 has been made to Life Haven. Life Haven is provides a temporary shelter to homeless pregnant women and women with young children in New Haven.

Lastly, on the first Sunday of each month a separate collection is taken for Global Mission. For 2019 the Vestry allocated this money to three different projects.

\$500 to Kateri Medical Services who provides medical care for poor people in Nigeria.

\$500 to SAMS/Women of Madagascar. The Society of Anglican Missionaries and Senders (SAMS) does work around the world. We are committed to helping the women of Madagascar.

\$500 to Fr. Charles' Project. Fr. Charles is organizing a nonprofit to benefit people in Guinea.
